Hi Nichole -

Sometime back, Rick ended up with a few viewport adapters from the 3IFO storage (likely an earlier Jodi arrangement) which he needed modified for camera use for H1/L1/3IFO. Long story short, he asked us to send them to LLO this week during his absence and we now see that they are in a 3IFO storage load in ICS:

As per our conversation, we have removed them from the storage load on ICS and are sending them to LLO. Issues with this that we need to follow up on are:

- 1) Why are there so many of these stowed away for 3IFO in this storage load-7133? Where did the total count come from? I suspect that some of these are actually SPARES.
- 2) Based on 1) above, we need to determine if we need to replace these with new ones since they may have actually been spares and not 3IFO ones.

The 3 pieces we have removed from the load are:

D080365-v2 - 155, 188, 226
